A vendor commits an offense under this section if the vendor knowingly violates Section 176.001, Local Government Code.

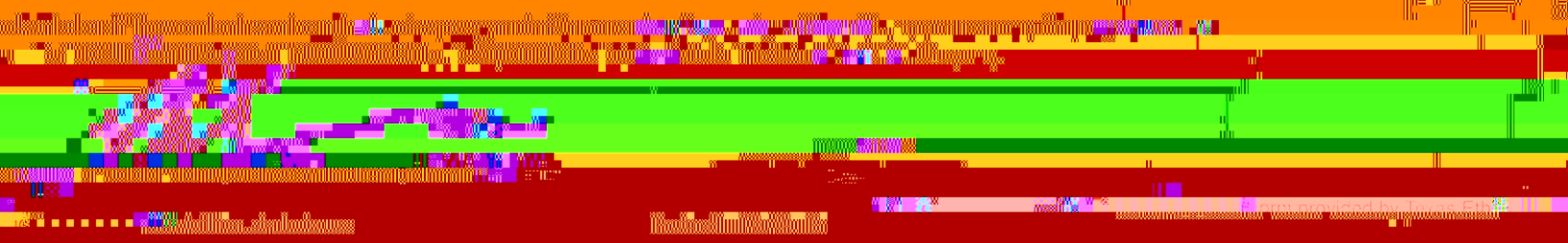
