Highly Qualified Instructional Materials have been approved by the Texas Education Agency as meeting 100% of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). If there is not an available OER for a content, the Teaching and Learning department shall assemble a committee of teacher representatives of each content and grade level to review each of the approved HQIM utilizing a rubric developed by the content coordinator. Each committee member will provide their top three choices in order of preference.

The content coordinator shall review all submissions from the committee to determine the resource most aligned with district practices and needs. Members of the committee will help lead the plan for successful implementation of the HQIM materials. The committee will utilize the HQIM provided scope and sequence, along with the lessons plans, texts, and assessments.
